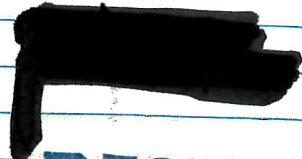
Dear M's Lowe,

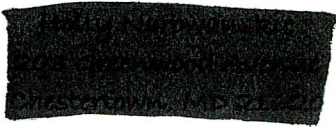
